### Certification Information Fact Sheet

#### **What is a Certification Meeting?**

Certification Information Meetings are designed to answer questions about elementary and secondary teacher certification requirements. The meetings are for individuals who have never been certified before and are interested in either:

- The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) Program
- The Post-Bachelor Certification Program

#### **Who should attend a Certification Information Meeting?**

You should plan to attend a Certification Information Meeting if you:

- Have never been a certified teacher
- Have earned a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college/university
- Are interested in obtaining a Michigan Provisional Teaching Certificate

#### **What should I bring to the Certification Information Meeting?**

You should bring student copies of **all** of your transcripts. Transcripts will be evaluated and mailed to you within 12-14 business days after the meeting.

#### **Where are the Student Center, David Adamany Undergraduate Library, Purdy Kresge Library and the College of Education?**

The Student Center and the College of Education buildings are located right next to each other in the center of Wayne State University's campus. David Adamany Undergraduate Library is located directly south of the Student Center and Purdy Kresge Library is located east of the student center.

#### **Where do I park when I come to the Certification Information Meetings held at Wayne State University's campus?**

Parking is available in parking structures #2 and #5, located on Anthony Wayne Drive and Kirby. Parking is also available in parking structure #1, located on Palmer between Cass Avenue and Anthony Wayne Drive. \$3.50 is required for parking. Parking structure #2 is open on weekends.
