Date	Discussion topics	Description
May 16, 2007	7 th Standard, 21 st Century Skills, & Digital Citizenship	Discussion and exploration of the proposed (and soon to be adopted) 7 th standard. Discussion and exploration of how 21 st Century Skills impacts our classrooms.
May 23, 2007	e-Portfolios (Blackboard)	Learn how to use the Content Collection in Blackboard by creating your own e-portfolio. Discussion will focus on how you can use this tool with your students.
May 30, 2007	Communication tools	Set up your own Skype and iChat accounts, explore how you can use these tools in your personal and professional life. See how you can share files and interact face-to-face through desktop video conferencing.
June 6, 2007	Digital storytelling	If you've never created a digital story, this is the workshop for you. This is a hands-on introductory workshop using iPhoto and iMovie to create a movie that can be used on your Blackboard site, for an e-portfolio, or just for fun.

June 13, 2007	Podcasting	Ever wonder what this podcasting stuff is all about? In this hands-on session we will explore tools for creating and using podcasts.
June 20, 2007	Social networking & other "cool" stuff	Have you heard about blogging? How about Second Life or Facebook? Discussion (and hands-on exploration) will focus on what social networking is and how people are using these tools for learning and communication.
June 27, 2007	Technology Resources	This session is hands-on exploration of online tools for teaching, learning, and research (e.g. Google tools, online tutorials, etc.).
July 11, 2007	Blackboard for faculty	This hands-on session is for faculty who would like to learn about the different Blackboard tools (e.g. Content Collection, assessment, gradebook, adding documents, etc.).
