

ATTENTION STUDENTS SUBMITTING PAPERS

In previous years the symposium has had difficulty in organizing and judging the student papers due to applications that were not properly filled out, papers that were not in the correct format, and various other paperwork problems. Therefore, the following list has been compiled to ensure that all papers are accepted for judging. Papers submitted to the **Forty-Sixth** Annual Junior Science and Humanities Symposium must follow the guidelines listed below and must be returned on or before

January 15, 2010

Students who do not follow the guidelines may cause a delay in the judging of papers and/or possible disqualification.

- **Students are not to put their name, school, sponsoring teacher, or any other personal information anywhere on or in their research paper.** A cover sheet with this information should be attached. (This allows for complete anonymity during judging.)
- **Students should follow *the Guidelines for the Preparation and Presentation of Research Papers* when typing their paper.** Items A through K under *General Instructions* must be included in the paper submitted for judging. Papers missing any of these sections will have points deducted from their final score.
- **Students need to be sure that all information on their *Student Application to Present Research Paper* is accurate and complete.** Missing information could result in judging delays.
- **Students must circle the category in which they wish to compete on the *Student Application to Present Research Paper*.** If this information is missing it is impossible to determine which area the paper should be judged in and will therefore result in delays in judging and possible disqualification.
